Communion Team Procedures

- All preparations and clean-up will be in the main kitchen in the gathering place. On Saturday evening pick up the communion supplies from the Celebrate sacristy and bring them to the kitchen.
- Communion Servers must wear a mask and gloves.
- The plant stands are in the aisles and should sit one household per row.
- Elements for the presider may be placed on the altar prior to worship and covered with white linens. Please use the brass chalice with about an inch of wine in it and paten with one wafer.
- We prepare each mini tray with 2 cups of wine (spread out evenly) and 2 wafers. Please prepare trays for the musicians, audio visual technicians, ushers, and yourself.
- The trays are placed on the stands after people are seated. Please adjust the number of cups and wafers and set trays only at the rows that people are seated.
- Gluten free wafers and grape juice will be available by request from the Communion Team (CT) during worship. Prepare a tray with only gluten free wafers and grape juice (maybe 10) and keep it close to the CT in the back. Please use the tongs to handle the gluten free wafers.
- Immediately after communion is served the CT can pick up all communion ware and clean up in the kitchen. Again, those doing the clean-up will need to wear gloves and masks. After the Sunday Festive worship all leftover cups and wafers should be thrown away. All trays are to be washed and dried by hand.
- After the Sunday Festive service please return all communion supplies to the Celebrate Center sacristy.
