# Ministry Spotlight Autumn Is on the Way!

For everything there is a season, Ecclesiastes tells us, and if you've noticed a slight yellowish tinge on certain trees' leaves, or an increase in squirrels' activity, or any number of other clues, you'll know that autumn is soon to come. No matter what the thermometer might say currently!

And autumn means things ramp up again around Our Savior's (not that they every really slow down that much). At this point, dreams are still being dreamed and plans are still being planned, but here are some things to look forward to from OSL's various ministry areas!



Kick-Off Sunday also marks the return of regular worship hours: Celebrate at 8:45 and 11:00 A.M., and Festive at 11:00 A.M. Saturday Festive worship will remain at 5:00 P.M.

  Pr. Randy envisions "a fellowship-based learning opportunity that includes a simple meal (maybe potluck), largegroup teaching, and small-group conversation."
- ◆ *Icons in Transformation*, a museum-quality art exhibit that will be present at OSL in October and November. This exhibit of works by the artist Ludmila Pawlowska will present unique opportunities to encounter the spiritual-

ity of traditional religious icons through contemporary art. Hosting the exhibit—which will feature 80 to 150 paintings, sculptures, installation art, and photographs of contemporary art inspired by traditional icons—will also provide numerous ways for OSL members and friends to volunteer, and it will invite the community to visit our church and become more familiar with Our Savior's as a "church of substance." Works will be available for purchase, with sales benefitting Ukrainian refugees.
