


Youth Group is in FULL swing!

PIZZA, PUMPKINS, AND PARADE!



One of the recommendations of the OSL Transition Task Force was to amend the OSL Constitution and Bylaws to institute a congregation lead church. A committee was formed and is ready to recommend an amended Constitution and updated Bylaws.

We intend to take the first vote on the revised constitution and bylaws on November 2nd with the second vote required to be taken at the Annual Meeting in January of 2026, per the current constitution.
