Pam Cole, Executive Director of Bread Break, who will speak between services on 3/22 at 10 am in the Friendship Room. This event is sponsored by the Creation Care Team Ministry to discuss the important stewardship of our abundant food resources. Have you considered the amount of food that is wasted each day? The reality is that over one-third of the U.S. food supply is wasted across the food chain from farmers to manufacturers to consumers. Recognizing the local need for collection and reallocation of unused food, **Bread Break** was established as a food recovery nonprofit that feeds the hungry, supports the Sioux Falls community, and reduces food waste. We will hear about this innovative volunteer program, how it has grown over the past decade, and its significant impact for Sioux Falls.

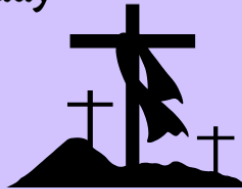

4 week Bible Study with Pastor Michael

Misunderstood Bible Passages

Sometimes the most quoted Bible verses are also the most misunderstood. In this four-week study we will explore passages that people often use in ways that miss their deeper meaning. Together we will look at the context of these verses and discover how the broader witness of scripture can lead us to richer and more compassionate interpretations. Come to one week or all four.

Week 1 - "Judge Not"

What did Jesus really mean when he said "Judge not"? We will explore the difference between condemnation and accountability and discover how Jesus calls us to humility rather than silence.

Week 2 - "Everything Happens for a Reason?"

Does the Bible really say God causes everything that happens? We will look at Romans 8 and other scriptures that speak honestly about suffering while still pointing to hope.

Week 3 - "I Can Do All Things"

Often used as a motivational slogan, this verse from Philippians actually speaks about endurance and contentment. What does it mean to find strength through Christ in difficult seasons?

Week 4 - "God Won't Give You More Than You Can Handle"

This familiar phrase is often attributed to the Bible but may not mean what we think. We will explore what scripture actually promises about temptation, struggle, and the importance of community.
