

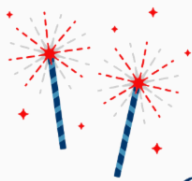

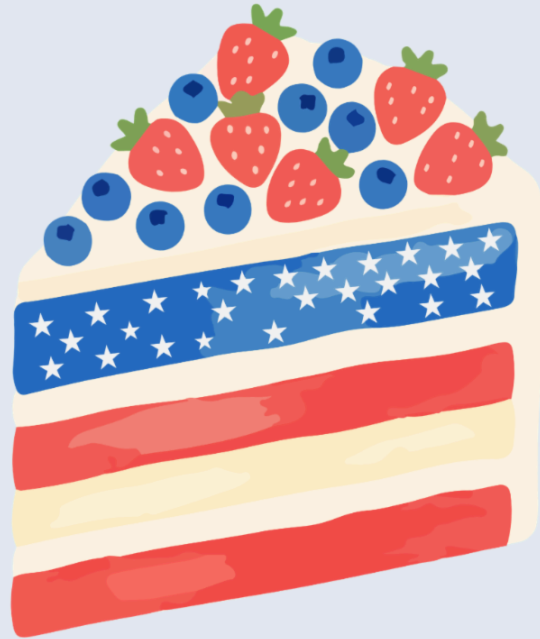

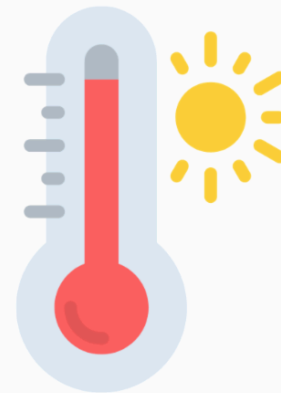

1 Corinthians 13:12-13

*<sup>12</sup>For now we see only a reflection, as in a mirror, but then we will see face to face. Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known. <sup>13</sup>And now faith, hope, and love remain, these three, and the greatest of these is love.*
