because your judgments are good.

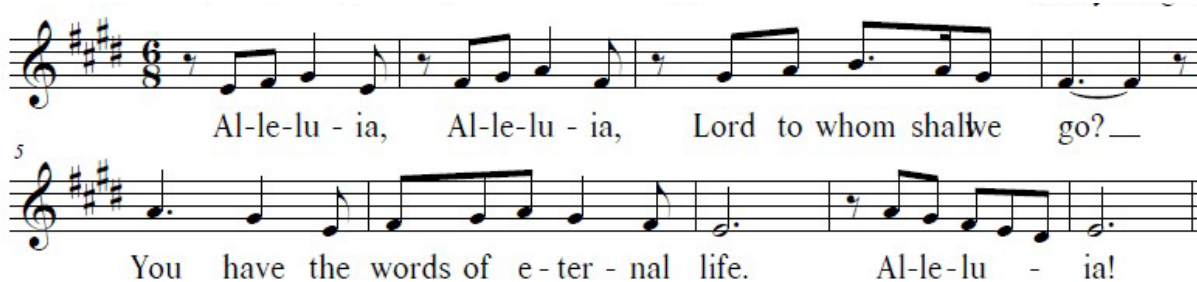

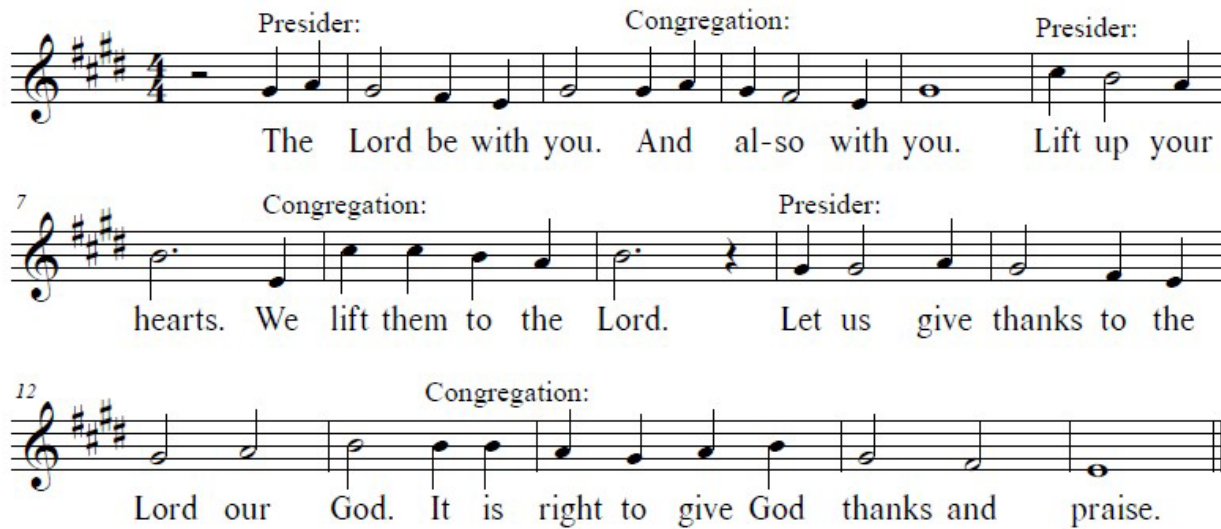
